The recipients are in the hospitals, therapy centers, or are at home recovering, recuperating, or grieving. These handmade items have been distributed locally, across the states and globally.

While items are being knitted or crocheted, they are being prayed over by the person or group making the items. After the shawls, sweaters, scarves, etc. are made they are dedicated on a Sunday morning during the worship service by the pastors and the congregation. They are selected for distribution and given to those in need of prayer. This is our way of showing extravagant generosity to those hurting, ill, or in need.
